DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT: **DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:** **On June 29, 2014 at approximately 1:00 a.m., Pembroke Pines Police Officers responded to a call of a missing juvenile (J'calah Kinsey) at the above location. The juvenile's mother reported that she saw her daughter when she went to bed, however she was not there when she awoke the next morning. The juvenile has run away several times in the past and has been recovered each time. The last time the juvenile was recovered, it was in the City of Miami. Today, Pembroke Pines Detectives responded to that same area where she was last recovered and residents stated that they saw her last night.**

Due to the age of the missing juvenile, there is concern that she can be exploited and in danger. We are asking for the public's assistance in locating her. She does not have any medical or mental conditions and is not on any known medications at this time.
