Since beginning program operations on March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2016, the Pembroke Pines Police Department has successfully conducted more than 80 compliance check and high visibility enforcement operations. These operations have targeted the illegal sale of alcohol to underage persons and the consumption and possession of alcohol by underage persons. This program will continue to run through to May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2016.

Alcohol vendors who are identified during the compliance check operations, that facilitate the illegal sale of alcohol to underage persons, will be offered the opportunity to attend an educational alcohol diversion program through the Sensible Education for Responsible Vendors & Employees (S.E.R.V.E.) Program, Inc.
