**DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:** At 6:20 pm on 10-24-13, units from the Pembroke Pines Police and Fire Departments responded to a single vehicle crash where a pedestrian (Azriel Graham) was struck at 16300 Pines Blvd. Preliminary investigation revealed that as Matthew Armstrong was driving a tow truck westbound on Pines Blvd, Graham stepped of the center median and into Armstrong’s path of travel. Armstrong’s vehicle struck Graham who sustained extensive injuries and was air-lifted to Memorial Regional Hospital in critical condition. This is an on going investigation and no charges have been filed at this time.
