Members of the Pembroke Pines Police Department responded to a report of an armed robbery that occurred at the Marathon fuel station located at 10070 Pines Boulevard.

A preliminary investigation revealed the suspect committed an armed robbery, forced the clerk to open the register drawer, and ran away from the business. As police officers were actively

searching the area, the suspect committed an armed carjacking near the Chevron fuel station located at 10255 Pines Boulevard.

Police officers spotted the stolen vehicle and attempted a traffic stop. However, the suspect refused to stop and drove away in an attempt to avoid arrest. After a short pursuit, the suspect bailed out and was apprehended.

None of the armed robbery victims were injured during this incident, nor was any member of the motoring public injured.

Additional charges are pending based upon the final outcome of this investigation.
