pool. Individuals at the residence performed CPR on the 4-year-old female until first responders arrived and took over.

A preliminary investigation indicates that the victim's family responded to the residential location to potentially rehome a dog. While there the 4-year-old wandered away unnoticed. When it became apparent she was missing, everyone began looking for her at which time she was found in the pool. An 8-year old boy jumped into the pool and helped remove the victim who was unresponsive and not breathing.

The juvenile victim was transported to a local hospital and is currently in critical, but stable condition.
