Sanura has been safely located by Pembroke Pines Police Department detectives and reunited with her family. She is in good health and we would like to thank our partners in the media and the community for your assistance.

Detectives are asking for assistance in locating an endangered missing 15-year-old, Sanura Domond. Sanura was last seen leaving her Pembroke Pines residence (318 SW 67th Terrace) at 8:00 a.m. on June 15th, 2021.

Sanura’s mother last spoke with her daughter over the phone later that day regarding her

whereabouts, and during the conversation Sanura became uncooperative and hung up the phone. Since that time Sanura has not returned home, and has not been in contact with her family.

Sanura is described as a 15-year-old black female, 5'6 in height, 120 lbs, with black hair, black eyes, and braces. She does not suffer from any known medical or mental conditions, and she can swim. Due to her age, she is considered to be endangered at this time.

It is believed that Sanura's last known location was a Chevron gas station in Lauderdale Lakes, as she left in the company of an unknown male driving an unknown vehicle.
