INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On Sunday, September 12th, members of the Pembroke Pines Police Department were notified by Silver Trail Middle School staff of a Snapchat conversation between three juveniles that contained threatening messages concerning the school.

Our Threat Assessment Team was immediately deployed to investigate this matter, and all three juveniles were identified. All of the juveniles currently attend Silver Trail Middle School. Contact was subsequently made with the suspects and their parents.

At this time there is no active or on-going threat to Silver Trail Middle School. Our agency has been in close contact with Broward County Public Schools during our investigation, to ensure the on-going safety of our school campuses.

All three suspects are being charged with a 2nd Degree Felony for making a written threat to do bodily harm or commit an act of terrorism (FSS 836.10), and Suspect #2 is additionally being charged with a 2nd Degree Felony for conspiracy to commit a criminal offense (FSS 777.04(2)). Our investigation into this incident remains on-going and additional information will be released as it becomes available.

Whether written as a joke or a prank, all threats made against our schools will be taken seriously. Threats of this nature are severe offenses, and any individual who has committed such acts will be charged accordingly. The Pembroke Pines Police Department and Broward County Public Schools have been creating and distributing strong messaging to its families about the severity of consequences that will occur to students who use social media or any other means to threaten our schools, students or teachers.

We are asking all parents to please take this moment and speak with your children as to the severe consequences for making threats to do harm, while encouraging that they report threats of which they are made aware.
