INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On September 17th, 2021 at approximately 3:12 am, while conducting routine patrol, a Pembroke Pines Police Officer heard what was believed to be gunshots coming from the parking lot located in the South West corner of Pines Blvd and University Drive. When officers arrived, no suspect(s) or victim(s) were located, but multiple shell casings were located in the parking lot.

A short time later a victim was located at a local hospital with gunshot wounds. He remains in critical condition.

This remains an active criminal investigation, and we are asking for assistance from the community in order to identify the suspected shooter(s).

This appears to have been an isolated incident with no continued threat to the area.
