At 1:45 a.m. on Tuesday, February 8, 2022, police officers responded to an injured male stabbed by a suspect. The incident occurred at the Shell gas station located at 13940 Pines Boulevard.

A preliminary investigation revealed that while the victim was tending to his vehicle, the suspect approached from behind and stabbed the victim in the back without any provocation. The suspect ran away before police officers arrived.

The victim was transported to a local area hospital and received treatment for non-life threatening injuries.

As police officers furthered the investigation, it was determined the suspect committed a commercial burglary at the Sergio's restaurant (located within the same plaza as the gas station) minutes before the stabbing. Later in the morning, police officers responded to a separate incident within the Spring Valley residential community reported at 4:29 a.m. While investigating this incident, police officers observed the suspect wanted in connection to the commercial burglary and stabbing.

The suspect was arrested and transported to BSO Main Jail and is facing the felony charge of commercial burglary. The stabbing incident remains ongoing and additional charges may be presented based upon the final outcome of the investigation.
