INCIDENT SUMMARY:

At 11:20 p.m. on May 30, 2022, the Pembroke Pines Police Department was notified of a single-vehicle traffic crash that occurred in the westbound lanes of Sheridan Street, just west of NW 136th Avenue.

When officers arrived, they observed the vehicle fully engulfed in flames in the center median of Sheridan Street. Pembroke Pines Fire Rescue personnel extinguished the flames, and the driver (an adult female) was subsequently located deceased inside of the vehicle.

Our initial investigation indicates that the driver was traveling westbound on Sheridan Street when she lost control of the vehicle, striking a palm tree in the center median. It is believed that speeding and alcohol use may be factors in this crash.

During the overnight hours, portions of Sheridan Street were temporarily closed as our officers conducted their investigation. This case remains active.
