***** UPDATE – July 5, 2022 *****

Following a thorough investigation into this incident, an arrest warrant was issued for 24-year-old Francy Marcos. She is currently in BSO Main Jail on one felony charge of Manslaughter With a Firearm.

Update at 10:15 a.m. on Sunday, 06.12.2022:

Our preliminary investigation has determined that the adult female was handling a firearm inside of the residence when it discharged and fatally struck the juvenile victim. Both individuals are family members. The firearm was discharged unintentionally due to negligence and mishandling.

This investigation is ongoing and charges will be forwarded to the State Attorney's Office at the conclusion.

The Pembroke Pines Police Department wants to remind the public to educate themselves on safely handling and securing firearms at all times.

At 6:29 p.m. on June 11, 2022, police officers responded to the community of Coconut Reef regarding a report of a shooting. Police officers located a juvenile male with a single gunshot wound. The juvenile was transported to Memorial Regional Hospital by Pembroke Pines Fire-Rescue and subsequently died despite all life-saving efforts.

All parties involved in this incident are cooperating with detectives.

This incident was isolated in nature, and no threat to the community exists. Our investigation remains on-going, and any additional information will be released as it becomes available.
