INCIDENT SUMMARY:

The Pembroke Pines Police Department is currently in the process of obtaining reaccreditation through the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation (CFA). The culmination of this process will take place from March 14, 2023 to March 16, 2023, as our agency will be hosting a team of assessors who will conduct a final assessment of our policies, practices, and facilities. This assessment is intended to measure the agency's compliance with 216 state-recognized standards necessary to maintain a properly functioning and fully accountable police department. Over the course of the assessment, the agency's policies will be reviewed, staff will be interviewed, and physical inspections will be made to our Police Headquarters, the West District Station, the Training Facility, and our field equipment.

Our Accreditation Manager, Robin Moss, will be facilitating the reaccreditation assessment process for our CFA Assessment team. As part of this process, we are inviting residents to

Upon completion of the CFA assessors' on-site examination, all findings will be submitted to the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation to determine if the Pembroke Pines Police Department has satisfied all requirements to obtain accreditation status. Once obtained, accreditation status is valid for a three-year period during which the department must maintain the standards of best practices set by CFA. After the three-year period is over, the agency is re-assessed through the same on-site examination process.

Through the Pembroke Pines Police Department's dedication to excellence, and the assistance of our CFA Program Manager Billy Walls, we are committed to exceeding the requirements for each CFA standard. We wish to thank our residents, business owners, and local media for their assistance during this process.
