INCIDENT SUMMARY:

It is with heavy hearts and great sadness that we announce the untimely death of Pembroke Pines Police Officer Charles “Charlie” Herring. While on duty, “Charlie” was involved in a tragic accident while riding his police motorcycle. A piece of debris fell from a tree striking Officer Herring, causing him to fall from his motorcycle.

Officer Herring succumbed to his injuries despite all lifesaving efforts from fellow officers and emergency medical professionals.

Officer Herring dedicated his life to public service and was a veteran of the United States Army. He also served as a police officer for the City of Starke (FL) for three years, before beginning his career as a Pembroke Pines Police Officer in June of 2002.
