INCIDENT SUMMARY:

Pembroke Pines Police Officers have one suspect in custody following a shooting which occurred last night within the Advenir at San Tropez apartment complex.

At 10:22 p.m. on April 10, 2023, police officers responded to 7850 NW 3rd Street and located an adult male victim with a single gunshot wound. The victim advised that he met the suspect through a social media website and arranged to meet her in the parking lot.

While the victim and suspect were sitting inside of the victim's vehicle, they began arguing. The victim told the suspect to leave his vehicle, but she refused. As the altercation continued, the suspect fired two shots at the victim, striking him once in the shoulder. The suspect then ran away inside of the community.

The victim immediately contacted 911 and was subsequently transported to Memorial Regional Hospital by Pembroke Pines Fire-Rescue with non-life-threatening injuries.

Responding officers identified the suspect as 18-year-old Esther Sanon and located her in a nearby apartment within the community. Following an extensive interview by detectives, Sanon was transported to BSO Main Jail where she faces charges of Attempted Murder and Carrying a Concealed Firearm.
