**INCIDENT SUMMARY:**

At 7:19 p.m. on May 1, 2023, Pembroke Pines police officers responded to 401 NW 103<sup>rd</sup> Avenue regarding a man who had just been stabbed.

Our preliminary investigation revealed that the suspect is the victim's neighbor. As the victim arrived at his apartment, he observed the suspect standing outside of the suspect's home. As the victim was entering his apartment, the suspect walked behind him and stabbed him in his back with a knife.

The suspect fled the area following this incident, and the victim's family notified police. The victim was transported to Memorial Regional Hospital by Pembroke Pines Fire-Rescue with non-life-threatening injuries.

The suspect was subsequently located by responding officers and taken into custody. At this time, a motive has not been determined, but mental health issues might be a factor. Our investigation remains on-going.

This incident appears to be isolated, with no continued threat to the area.

Prida will be transported to BSO Main Jail, where he faces charges of Aggravated Battery with a Deadly Weapon.
