**INCIDENT SUMMARY:**

On Saturday, November 11<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at 01:43 a.m., members of the Pembroke Pines Police Department responded to a 911 call of a shooting within a residence.

When police officers arrived, they contacted an adult female (mother) and her juvenile son, inside of their home.

The officer's investigation revealed that the adult female had fallen asleep on her living room couch while her son had fallen asleep upstairs in his room earlier in the evening. The mother and son live alone together and no one else stays at their home.

While the mother was sleeping on the couch, she was startled awake by a noise in her kitchen. Fearing that it was an intruder, she removed a firearm that she had concealed in her purse next to her in the living room.

When she went to investigate the source of the noise, her son walked out of the kitchen simultaneously as she walked into the kitchen. Both were startled by each other's presence and the

mother accidentally fired her gun twice, striking the floor once and inadvertently, striking her son in his leg.

The victim was transported to a local hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

The Investigations Division of the Pembroke Pines Police Department was contacted to further investigate the incident. The Department of Children and Family was also contacted.

There does not appear to be any criminal intent at this time, and our investigation remains on-going.
