INCIDENT:

On Saturday, February 22, 2025, at 1:28 p.m., Pembroke Pines police officers were dispatched to a call involving a subject trespassing on private property and wandering shoeless in an undeveloped marsh.

When Mr. Noisy was noticed by police, he was walking through a marsh area inhabited by dangerous wildlife and acting in an unusual manner. Officers spoke with Mr. Noisy about his situation, asked for his name, and whether help could be provided. Mr. Noisy's response to the officers was not normal and he grew agitated.

As officers tried to gather basic information, Mr. Noisy's erratic behavior and failure to follow lawful verbal commands forced a police officer to spray chemical agent (pepper spray) which was

ineffective in allowing officers to detain him. It was then necessary to use an electronic control device (taser) to detain Mr. Noisy.

Since a fire rescue truck could not access the area where Mr. Noisy was located, a police officer drove him a short distance to an awaiting ambulance for medical care. Pembroke Pines Fire Rescue transported Mr. Noisy to a local hospital where he died approximately three hours later.

This incident is being investigated by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, as per standard protocol. Additional updates will be released by FDLE as information becomes available.
