INCIDENT SUMMARY:

Detectives are investigating a stabbing which occurred in the 7600 block of westbound Pines Boulevard.

At 8:55 a.m., dispatchers received a 911 call advising that a man attacked another man with a knife.

A preliminary investigation revealed that 26 year old Keano Johnson and 37 year old Chuck Leigh Forbes were within a coin laundry business. Forbes stole personal items belonging to Johnson and ran out of the business. Johnson gave chase and stabbed Forbes with a knife once in his back.

Forbes was transported to a local area hospital with injuries that are not life-threatening.

Both men were arrested. Forbes is facing theft charges and Johnson is facing charges related to the stabbing.

There are no suspects at large and no continued threat to the community exists.
