### **INCIDENT SUMMARY:**

On Sunday, March 30, 2025, the Pembroke Pines Police Department was alerted to a threatening text message exchange between two juvenile victims and multiple juvenile suspects. The texts were initially related to a romantic relationship that involved one of the victims and one of the suspects.

During the text conversation, multiple threats to kill the two victims were made by the suspects and an image of a gun was shared in the chat. After the direct threat was made, one of the victims contacted 9-1-1 and reported it to the FortifyFL app.

Police officers contacted the victims, and our Threat Assessment Team was dispatched to conduct an investigation.

Although both victims attend Franklin Academy (18800 Pines Boulevard), no threats were made toward the campus during any of the text exchanges. Due to the nature of the threats, Franklin Academy school administrators were made aware of our ongoing investigation.

Investigators identified and located three juvenile suspects, none who live or attend school in Pembroke Pines.

All three suspects surrendered themselves to the Pembroke Pines Police Department and were transported to the Juvenile Assessment Center facing the charge of felony Written Threats to Kill (Florida State Statute 836.10).

PARENTS, please speak to your children about the seriousness of making threats towards others. Even if a joke, written threats can result in a felony charge and a criminal record.
