INCIDENT SUMMARY:

Pembroke Pines police officers have taken Jose Rodriguez-Julio into custody following a shooting that occurred in the parking lot of the Mobil gas station located at 12351 Taft Street.

On May 12, 2025, multiple 911 calls were received about a shooting that occurred near Flamingo Road & Taft Street.

Based on the investigation, the victim and suspect agreed to meet at a gas station to discuss a landlord tenant dispute. Jose Rodriguez-Julio, tenant, arrived first and waited for his landlord. As soon as Jose Rodriguez-Julio noticed the victim arrive, he approached the vehicle while armed with a gun.

The victim, in fear of his own life, armed himself with a gun and fired shots at Jose Rodriguez-Julio. None of the bullets hit Jose Rodriguez-Julio or any other bystander.

After the shooting, the victim ran a short distance away from the gas station and called 911. Jose Rodriguez-Julio drove away in his vehicle.

Investigators acted quickly and contacted Jose Rodriguez-Julio, who surrendered himself to the Pembroke Pines Police Department.

This incident is isolated between both parties and no other threat to the community exists.

Jose Rodriguez-Julio is being charged with Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon and was transported to BSO Main Jail for processing.
