INCIDENT SUMMARY:

The Pembroke Pines Police Department will be participating in the High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) campaign to promote pedestrian and bicycle safety education efforts, beginning October 20, 2025, and will run through to May 8, 2026.

This campaign is funded through a contract with the University of North Florida (Institute of Police Technology and Management) in partnership with the Florida Department of Transportation's focused initiative to improve pedestrian and bicycle safety.

The goal of this enforcement effort is to increase awareness of and gain voluntary compliance with traffic laws that protect the safety of pedestrians and bicyclists.

Enforcement efforts will primarily focus on educational efforts offered to drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists at intersections. However, violations may result in written warnings or citations
